On Friday, 28th March, all Year 7 students will have the exciting opportunity to visit Rother Valley Country Park near Sheffield. This trip supports their current Geography topic, "*Can Water be Managed?*" and will allow students to explore the unique geological features of the area.

The day will include coach travel to and from Rother Valley Reservoir and a walk of approximately two miles around the reservoir. The walk is accessible for all students, following well-maintained paths, pavements, and gentle inclines.
